

MADE Withdrawal Policies

Application Deposit

Refundable if:

- The program is canceled by MADE
- The student's home institution prohibits them from participating
- The student does not meet MADE admission requirements

Confirmation Fee

Refundable if:

- The program is canceled by MADE
- The student's home institution prohibits them from participating
- The student does not meet MADE admission requirements

Program withdrawal must be issued in writing to MADE.

WITHDRAWAL 61 OR MORE DAYS PRIOR TO PROGRAM

START DATE:

The student remains responsible for the application deposit and confirmation fee. All other fees will be refunded.

WITHDRAWAL 46–60 DAYS PRIOR TO THE PROGRAM

START DATE:

The student remains responsible for the application deposit, confirmation fee, and any non-recoverable fees paid by MADE on the student's behalf.

WITHDRAWAL 30–45 DAYS PRIOR TO THE PROGRAM

START DATE:

The student remains responsible for the application deposit, confirmation fee, and 50% of the overall program cost.

WITHDRAWAL 7–30 DAYS PRIOR TO THE PROGRAM START DATE:

The student remains responsible for 100% of the program fees.

WITHDRAWAL 7–0 DAYS PRIOR TO OR ANYTIME AFTER THE PROGRAM START DATE:

The student remains responsible for 100% of the program fees

Session Deferral

If a student wishes to defer their enrollment to a future session, they must notify MADE in writing. The student's fees paid can be transferred to their new program session as long as they notify MADE at least 45 days prior to the program start date.

Special Circumstances

In the case of serious illness or family emergency, with official medical documentation, all recoverable costs will be refunded, less any program deposits.

NOTE: These policies apply to students enrolling directly in MADE study abroad programs, including Semester, Summer, Grand Tour, Gap, and MADE Labs. Withdrawal policies for customized faculty-led programs will be determined in collaboration with the partner institution.
